Established by Michael Quinlan in 1963, Kerry Fish is a family-owned seafood business based in Caherciveen, Co Kerry. Continuing on Michael's legacy, today, his three sons, Liam, Ronan and Fintan run the business. As a multi-strand operation, the company has grown to include a fish processing factory at its head office in Renard, Co. Kerry, fish shops in Caherciveen, Killorglin, Killarney and Tralee, and latterly five seafood restaurants in Killarney, Tralee, Killorglin and Cork. Since the establishment of Kerry Fish, it has been recognised as supplying the finest sustainable seafood from Ireland's west coast to customers worldwide. The company's philosophy is to use artisan skills, age-old recipes and the finest fresh ingredients to bring customers the best wild, organic and superior Irish smoked salmon.

### **Spotlight Target Area: Supplier Certification**

Kerry Fish are committed to a healthy future for the Irish fishing sector and demonstrate this in a sustainable way to ensure there will be plenty of fish for the future.

One such endeavour on which the business has been consistently focused is organically sourcing salmon. Kerry Fish aims to increase this organic salmon supply by 10% yearly, as set out in its robust Origin Green plan. In 2021, the company successfully increased organic salmon production from 22% to 33%. Kerry Fish also source its farmed products from Aquaculture Stewardship Council (ASC) certified farms.

Overall, the company demonstrated an outstanding performance throughout 2021, showcasing an exemplary performance across a number of key target areas, including Packaging, Energy, and Water, as well as Supplier Certification.
